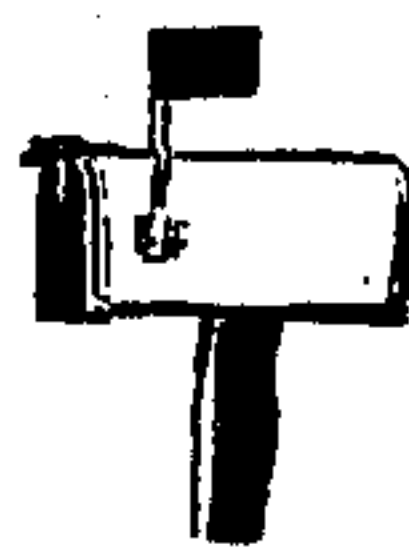

**SOME OF THE REGULATIONS  
GOVERNING DOGS IN  
ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY, MARYLAND**

**263-6441**

1. Licenses are required for all dogs four months old or older.
2. Licenses are due January 1 each year or within thirty days of the date the dog is acquired or brought into the County. A penalty is imposed for each month or fraction for delinquency on licenses not obtained before February 1, or when due and payable.
3. All owners of animals shall provide such animals with sufficient food and water, proper shelter, veterinary care when needed to prevent suffering, and with humane care and treatment. No person shall poison any animal other than household pests, deliberately mistreat or abandon any animal in such manner as to cause suffering by such animal. All owners of animals shall exercise care and control of such animals so as to prevent same from becoming public nuisances. Excessive noise, molesting pedestrians, chasing vehicles, depositing excretory matter on property other than that of the owner, damaging property and running at large shall, among other acts, be deemed public nuisances.
4. No owner of a dog, whether licensed or unlicensed, shall permit such dog to run at large off the premises of the owner in Anne Arundel County, except when it is under the control of the owner or authorized agent of the owner by leash, cord or chain; provided, however, certain dogs will be permitted to run at large in open agricultural areas when accompanied by the owner or an authorized agent and kept within sight or calling distance; this includes dogs being used for hunting, or being trained for hunting, under supervision of the owner; and dogs being accompanied by the owner on horseback.

## STATE IS TWELFTH IN PERSONAL PAY

The per capita income of Marylanders rose to \$3,204 last year and now ranks twelfth among the states, according to the Department of Economic Development.

The department said the annual rate of growth in Maryland was 8.4 percent, below the national gain.

Civilian income rose by \$702,000,000, primarily on the strength of an increase in manufacturing and wholesale and retail trade.


